Friday, August 6th/ Information for All Students:

The school will be open from 8:00am-11:00am for students (1st through 12th grade) to come and meet their teachers, drop off their supplies, tour the building, pick up schedules, or set up their lockers. Teachers will be available and parents are encouraged to attend. This is a come and go day for students.

Dismissal for Monday, August 9th:

Elementary Students will start dismissal at 2:30pm and must exit through the double carpool lines at the FRONT of the building.

Middle School Students will start dismissal at 2:50pm and must exit through the REAR of the building behind the main gym.

High School Students will start dismissal at 2:50pm and must exit through the FRONT doors at the UPPER School end of the building. NOTE: Please be patient—dismissal will be slow the first couple of weeks. Parents, display your carpool number and be sure your child knows their number.

Notes from the Finance Office

It is not too late to purchase the tuition refund plan for the 2010/11 school year. Trinity offers this insurance plan to protect the annual commitment under the terms of the tuition contract. All families who have signed enrollment contracts are obligated for the full year's tuition unless the tuition refund plan is chosen and payment is made by the due date. This insurance must be paid for by August 6, 2010 to be effective for the 2010/11 year. Only TCA uniforms and other TCA items will be accepted for the sale. Please make sure your items are in GOOD condition. If you would not buy them, chances are, no one else will.

We are asking that you only use 3 X 5 index cards and safety pins to tag your items. Please do not cut your cards in half or use larger cards. This could result in loss of card. Please follow the example below for completing your index cards. By doing this correctly, sorting through cards and keeping items together during and after the sale will be much easier.

All new consigners, may call **Lisa Northcut at 668-6736** to obtain a seller number. **If you participated in the sale in August of 2009, you may use your same seller number.** Please call Lisa if you need to confirm that number. Sellers will receive 60% of the sale price. The school will keep the remaining 40%.
