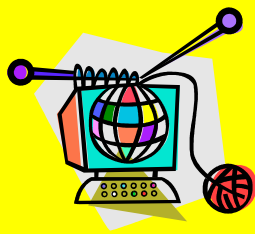

PreK, Kindergarten, 7th Grade or New Students!!



There is now one official TDOH certificate of immunization that must be filled out by medical providers for parents to give to schools before their child(ren) begin next fall. This form is only available from a private healthcare provider or local health department.

It is not necessary to copy the information from the previous immunization certificate on the new certificate – they may be stapled together. Enrolled children who are entering the 7th grade are no longer required to show proof of the hepatitis B vaccine, but must show proof of two new immunizations: Tetanus-diphtheria-pertussis booster (“Tdap”) and Verification of immunity to varicella (2 doses or history of disease).

This form needs to be turned in to the Admissions Office by the time school begins in August.

Driver Education Information/REPLY NEEDED SOON!

Trinity is considering offering Driver Education for the 2011-12 school year. There would be one class in the fall, one class in the spring, and one class in the summer. Each class would be limited to 20 students. During the fall and spring, classes would coincide with the student's study hall. The cost is \$350 per student. Trinity will target 10th, 11th, and 12th grade students in the fall; and 9th, 10th, and 11th grade students in the spring and summer. Attention 15 Year Old Students!

You are required to present a Certificate of Compulsory School Attendance form to be able to obtain a driver's permit in the State of Tennessee.

During the summer months, please make plans ahead of time and come by the office to pick one up! The forms are valid for 30 days and are required by the DMV at the time that you are tested. Please make note of the school office hours and plan ahead so that this does not delay your obtaining a permit to drive.

Dear Parents,

The "Personal History" section should be completed and signed by a parent in advance of the physical taking place.

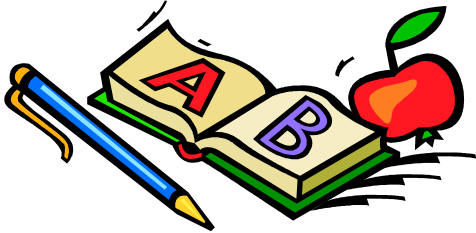

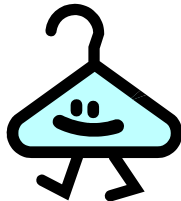
